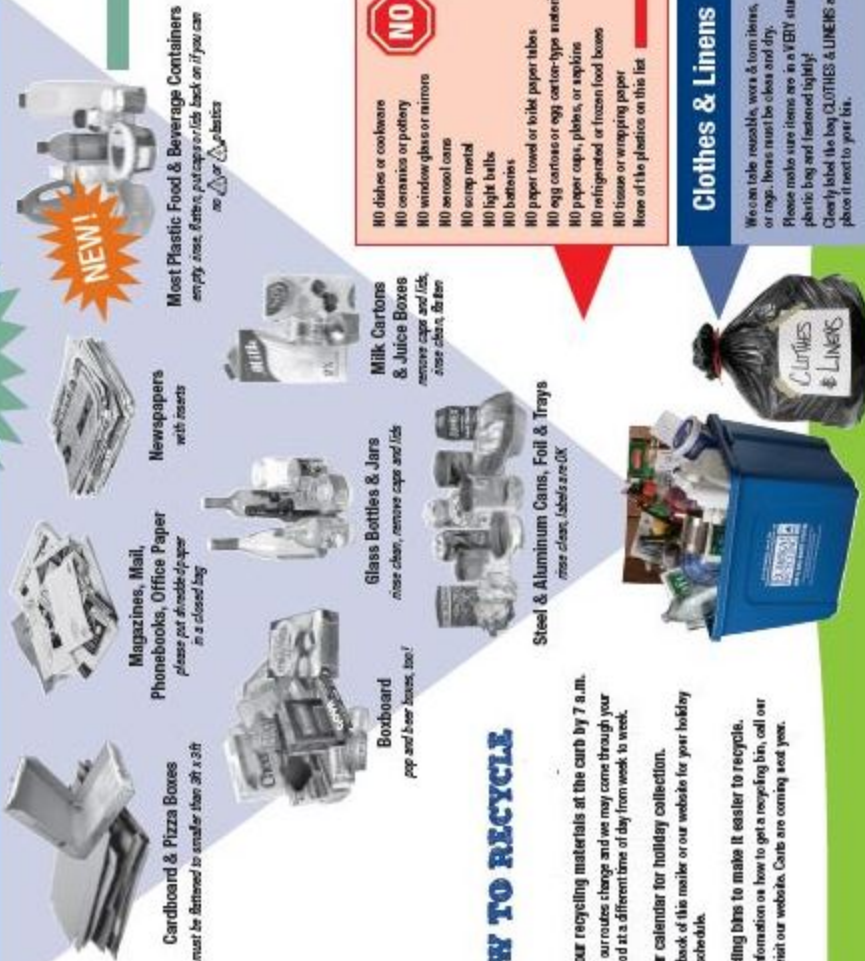


# Recycle All of These Items TOGETHER in Your Bin



## HOW TO RECYCLE

- ▶ Set out your recycling materials at the curb by 7 a.m. Sometimes our routes change and we may come through your neighborhood at a different time of day from week to week.
- ▶ Mark your calendar for holiday collection. Check the back of this notice or our website for your holiday collection schedule.
- ▶ Get recycling bins to make it easier to recycle. For more information on how to get a recycling bin, call our hotline or visit our website. Cans are coming next year.

## SIMPLE GUIDELINES FOR PLASTICS RECYCLING

As a general rule, most food and beverage containers are recyclable (and some containers from your bathroom and laundry room, too).



**Bottles**  
pop, juice, water, detergent, laundry & dish soap

**Produce Containers**  
(salads, berries, etc.)

**Yogurt, Cottage Cheese & Butter Containers**

**Transparent Deli "To-go" Containers**

If you want to be sure that a specific product is really going to be recycled, call our hotline or check our website.

**Beware of & !**  
These are more and more plastic containers and packages being used that look identical to packaging made with or . Try to avoid and if you can, and please keep them out of your list! They are not recyclable, and producers need to know that they should stop making products with these types of plastics!



These plastic items are **not** recyclable. However, just because it's on the "no" list doesn't mean it needs to be trash! Call us for ideas!

- NO motor oil bottles
- NO bottles used for home needle disposal
- NO or plastic
- NO foam egg cartons or Styrofoam™
- NO disposable cups, plates, or utensils
- NO bulky items such as lawn furniture, kiddie pools, etc.
- NO toys
- NO plastic bags or film (call for other recycling options)
- NO containers that hold hazardous materials
- NO containers larger than 3 gallons
- NO packaging from toys and electronics
- NO plant or landscaping pots
- NO black plastic, including microwave food trays
- NO compostable materials (other material with a )
